

# New Arrivals in Lambeth

Induction Course  
Revised 2013

## Who is this course suitable for?

- New arrivals to the UK aged 12 or above
- Pupils with age appropriate literacy in their first language
- Pupils who have learned some English at school in their home country
- Pupils assessed at stages 1 to 2 using the Lambeth stages of English
- Pupils assessed as Entry level 1 to 2 using the Adult ESOL curriculum

## How much time is needed?

- 3x 2hour lessons each week as part of an otherwise mainstream provision (for one term).
- 5x 2hour lessons each week as a stand alone course prior to entering mainstream schooling (for 8 weeks)
- In each case pupils should have access to normal provision such as PE, maths, art, drama, music and school dinner

## Course materials

The course is based on New Headway Elementary (OUP), as we feel it to be the most user friendly and age appropriate course available. Each pupil should have access to a textbook. Alongside the main text, Headway produces supplementary workbooks, resource books, CDs and other free online resources which may be used to supplement the lessons. It is not necessary to use Headway if another course book is available in school – there are many other broadly similar schemes - but the lessons will not quite ‘match’ the notes given here.

Essential **Pre Activities** and three projects have been incorporated –

- **‘Food and Shopping’** Amanda Gay (AGa) and Kelly Ditroia (KD)
- **‘Sport / Extreme Sports’**, written by Kathy Jacobs (KJ) and AGa
- **London**, based on: landmarks (AG); day trip; the books: *Through Time: London* with supplementary worksheets written by Anthony Gunning (AGu); *The Tudors*, with supplementary worksheets by KD

In addition, lessons should incorporate

- ✓ Speaking and listening: pair work, rôle plays, hot seating activities, DARTS, board games and or card games. Examples of these have been listed or are supplied in paper format or electronically
- ✓ Group reading (usually but not always fiction). A list of suitable readers is to be found at the back of this document.
- ✓ Reading Comprehension activities
- ✓ Non fiction reading and interpretation of charts and tables.
